7. **PROCUREMENT OF MACHINERY/ARTICLES UNDER SWACHHTA ACTION PLAN 2019-2020 :**  
Ref: PD DE SC letter No. 8078/Grant-in-Aid/VI/DE dated 03.12.2019.

The PD DE SC Pune vide their above referred letter, has intimated that the Grant-in-Aid for SAP for the year 2019-2020 amounting to Rs. 50,00,000/- has been allotted to Belgaum Cantonment and the same has been credited to Cantonment Fund Account.

The above amounts have already been projected in the budget provision. The details of Machinery/ Materials to be procured are as under:-

1. 4000 or 6000 Liters capacity Water Tanker mounted on Tata SFC 407 or 709 chassis.
2. Jetting Machine mounted on Tata make small commercial vehicle.
3. Desilting machine mounted on Tata make small commercial vehicle.
4. Vermi-compost Machine.
5. Sanitary equipments.

The Board may consider the issue of procurement of above Machinery/ Materials.

Sanitary Inspector's report along with the concerned documents are placed on the table.

7. Shri. Sajeed Nazirsab Shaikh, Elected Member informed that 4000 litres capacity Water Tanker mounted on Tata SFC 407 be purchased. The PCB informed the Board that a machine for disposal of organic waste be purchased instead of vermi-compost bins after consulting the State Pollution Control Board office. After detailed discussion, it is resolved that only those machinery / materials which are necessary and useful, should be procured in order to curb the expenditure. The CEO is authorized to incur the necessary expenditure for procurement of necessary equipments.

**9. TERMINATION OF LEASE OF GLR SY. NO. 251/831 BEARING HOUSE NO. 25, KHANAPUR ROAD, BELGAUM CANTONMENT.**

As per the records of this office, the land of GLR Sy. No. 251/831, total admeasuring 3000 Sqft. described as H.No. 25, Khanapur Road was initially leased to Shaikh Dawood of Camp, Belgaum for a term of 99 years w.e.f. 09/07/1918 in form 'C' of Cantonment code 1912, for the purpose of own use i.e. for Residential purpose on payment of yearly rent of Rs. 1/- . The lease was executed on 09/07/1918 and registered on 02/08/1918 in the office of the Sub-Registrar, Belgaum at No. 1172 pages 48-50.

The Lease term of 99 years has expired on 08/07/2017. As per lease condition No. VII (2) after expiry of the said term of 99 years the lessee may be granted a renewal of the lease for a further period of 99 years, such renewal and the period thereof to be at the discretion of the Officer Commanding the Division. As per condition no.III, the land shall not to be used for any purpose other than those specified in the Lessee's application. As per condition no.VI(2),If the lessee erects any buildings or makes any alteration or addition otherwise that as allowed by or under Condition II, the Cantonment Authority may by notice in writing require him to remove the building or to alter the same to the satisfaction, and if he fails to comply with such notice the Cantonment authority may after giving him six hours' further notice in writing cause each removal or alteration to be effected and recover the cost from him. As per condition No. IX(2) ,.If at the expiry of the said term of 99 years the Officer Commanding the Division in the exercise of his dis-erection declines to renew the lease, the lessee shall deliver up to the Local Government and without any compensation whatever therefore the land comprised in this demise together with all erections and buildings which may standing thereon on

payment of compensation for such erections and buildings only as shall have been erected under proper authority.

As per GLR records bearing GLR Sy. No. 251/831 measuring 3000 Sqft. is standing in the name of Shri. Dastgir S/o Ameensaheb Mujawar. The recorded lessee has expired on 06/04/2016. The Legal heirs of lessee Smt. Bibiayesha Dastagir Mujawar & 5 others vide their letter dt. 04/04/2017 have applied for renewal of further period of lease. They have also applied for mutation of the said property on 15/05/2017.

There is no encroachment on Govt. Land existing in the said premises. There exists change of purpose by way of commercial shops. There exists unauthorized construction of first floor which is not within the permissible FSI. The notice under section 248 of Cantonment Act 2006 has been issued for the unauthorized construction of First Floor vide this office letter No. H.No. 25/Khanapur Road/1703 dt. 09/03/2017 . The unauthorized constructions carried out by the lessee/occupants cannot be regularized due to violation of the prevailing FSI. The occupants were asked to remove the unauthorized construction vide this office letter No. 25/Khanapur Road/1483 dt. 24/12/2019, which violates the prescribed FSI i.e. 1.00. They have not yet removed the said unauthorized construction.

The Govt. of India, Ministry of Defence vide their letter No. 18/48/L/De/57 dated 10/03/2017 has formulated the Policy for the Leases of Cantonment codes 1899 & 1912 and CLAR 1924 & 1927. The fresh proposal has to be forwarded to the committee constituted by the PDDE for determination of the lease in question.

9. Considered and approved. The Elected Members requested to grant 15 days time to the legal heirs of lessee to demolish the unauthorised construction which is in excess of F.S.I. 1.00. The Board resolved that if the legal heirs of lessee do not remove the unauthorised construction in question within 15 days, the proposal be forwarded to the Committee appointed by the Principal Director, DE, SC, Pune for determination of lease in question.

**11.** Considered and approved. The PCB informed the Board that the possibility of preparation of land use plan only be explored in minimum charge instead of preparation of development plan. After detailed discussion, it is resolved that the work in question be executed through the lowest tenderer **Vision Solutions** at the cost of Rs. 12,50,000.00 only after considering the financial position.

**12. REMOVAL OF STALL FOR CONSTRUCTION OF PROJECT "WHITE TOPPING, PACKAGE - 2" :**

To consider the letter dated 31-12-2019 received from the Managing Director, Smart City Ltd, Belgaum requesting to remove the encroachment in front of Pranam Hotel besides Cantonment Board Office since the stall in question is within the right of way of the Khanapur Road.

The site in question is not an encroachment. The said land is Class 'C' land bearing GLR Sy.No. 278 measuring 1676 Sq.ft. given to the Cantonment Board for the purpose of Octroi Post. It was given on lease for running a Canteen to **Shri. Y. Jagjivandas** for a period of 5 years w.e.f. 1-1-2007 to 31-12-2012. Thereafter, the request letters dated 31-12-2011 and 05-9-2012 received from **Shri. Y. Jagjivandas**



requesting for extension of leasehold rights, were referred to the Cantonment Board meeting held on 8-11-2012 and the Board vide CBR No. 21 dated 8-11-2012 resolved to reject the applications of Shri. Y. Jagjivandas for extension of leasehold rights and also resolved that the said Octroi Naka Building be got vacated and the applicant be charged damage charges @ Rs. 3,000/- per month for the occupation of the building after the expiry of the lease period.

The land on which the said Octroi Naka Building / shop is existing, is defence land classified as Class 'C' and can only be transferred to the State Govt. with the sanction of the Govt. of India, Ministry of Defence.

The Board may decide further course of action in the matter.

Report of the AE & RS, is placed on the table.

12. Considered and resolved that since the subject land is Class 'C', the case be dealt as per recent guidelines mentioned in the MoD letter No, 11015/2/2012/D(Lands) dated 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2016 circulated vide DG DE, Delhi Cantt. letter No. 751/41/L/DE/2012 dated 26<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2016. The DEO, Bangalore may be requested to give their opinion within 15 days regarding location of G.L.R.Sy.No.278 in road width of 24 mtrs of Khanapur road or not. Thereafter further course of action be taken.

13. **HANDING OVER OF LTUG CABLE AND STREET LIGHTS INSTALLED BY CITY CORPORATION, BELAGAVI :**

To consider the letter No. CCB/ELE/2019-20/1487 dated 17-1-2020 received from the Commissioner, City Corporation, Belagavi requesting to take over following assets created by the City Corporation, Belagavi in Belgaum Cantonment area. The details are as follows :--

- 1) High Street (LTUG cable and Street lights).
- 2) Church Street (Street lights).
- 3) Kondappa Street (Street lights).
- 4) Police Quarters (Street lights).
- 5) From Postman Circle to Globe Theatre (Street lights).

The Street lights have been installed in Cantonment area. The same are to be charged by installing Energy Meter to be registered in the name of the Chief Executive Officer, Cantonment Board, Belgaum.

The Board may consider the issue of completing the formalities for charging of the assets created by the City Corporation, Belagavi and take over the same for further maintenance.

The concerned letter along with the AE's report is placed on the table.

**Resolution :**

**13.** Considered and resolved that a detailed report be prepared and sent to the Corporation authorities regarding non payment of Street light bills through SFC grant. Since Cantonment Board is not having sufficient funds, it is resolved to take up the matter with the State Government authorities to pay the HESCOM charges of street light bills under SFC Grant.

**Agenda :**

**14. ANNUAL CONTRACT FOR COLLECTION OF PARKING FEES FROM 2,3,4 & 6 WHEELERS IN BELGAUM CANTONMENT AREA FOR THE YEAR 2019-20 :**

To consider tender proceedings dated 02-01-2020. A tender notice bearing No. 13/REV/82/Parking Fees/I/1417 dated 10-12-2019 has been published in local news paper inviting the tenders from the registered firms through e-tendering for the Annual Contract for collection of parking fees from 2,3,4 & 6 wheelers in Belgaum Cantonment Area for the year 2019-20.

The technical bid was opened on 02-01-2020. It was found that only a single bid was received from **Shri Sagar Babu Kamanache** and the name of the firm and the name of the firm's proprietor are same. Hence on 13-01-2020, the matter was referred to Shri A. S. Somannavar, legal advisor to examine the case in legal point of view and also to opine whether the single bid quoted by **Shri Sagar Babu Kamanache** is acceptable or not. The legal advisor vide his letter dated 18-01-2020, has opined and advised as under :-

The sole bidder has registered his firm under the name and style of "Sagar Kamanache" with the concerned departments and has also obtained mandatory registration and compliances viz., PAN, TAX, GST, ESI and Registration with the Labour Department. Hence there is no legal bar on the sole bidder preventing him from having and running a firm legally which is under the name and style of his own name. Further he has opined that the Board follow all the terms and conditions of the tender and allot the same to the sole bidder. Since tender was called for by the Board through advertisements in the City of Belagavi and also since, the tender process was online, open for all, the tender process is valid. The Board cannot ensure minimum or maximum number of bidders who participated in such tenders. However, since there is only one bidder who participated in the process, it is upto the discretion and the satisfaction of the Board to allot the task to the sole bidder if the Board is satisfied with the monetary aspect of the bid as there is no comparison available. His opinion has the following conclusion :-

1. There is no legal bar if the name of the firm and the name of firm's proprietor is the same.
2. The sole bidder may be allotted the task at the discretion and satisfaction of the Board with respect to the monetary aspect of the bid as there is no comparison available.

After obtaining the legal opinion the financial bid was opened on 18-01-2020. The estimated tender value for the said tender was **Rs.29,60,000/-** The previous contract amount was **Rs.26,60,000/-** and the bid value received from Shri Sagar Kamanache is **Rs.19,26,000/-** p.a. which is much less than the estimated value of present tender and the contract amount of previous year. It is also noticed that the contractor has enclosed the experience certificate of collection of vendors fees instead of collection of parking fees.

However it is brought to the notice of the Board that the collection of parking fees in Belgaum Cantonment is tremendously reduced due to the shifting of Wholesale Vegetable Market and Smart City Project work. At present the Board is receiving parking fees @ Rs. 75000/- per month (Approx). In view of the present circumstances the bid received by Shri Sagar B. Kamanache seems to be quite reasonable.

As per rule 173(xx) of GFR 2017, single bid can be accepted if the procurement was satisfactorily advertised and sufficient time was given for submission of bids. The qualification criteria were not unduly restrictive and prices are reasonable in the comparison to market values.

The Matter is brought before the Board for their consideration and to take suitable decision.

Reports of the Evaluation Committee and the Revenue Supdt. is placed on the table.

**Resolution :**

**14.** Considered the matter at length. CEO apprised the Board that as per GFR rule 173(xx) of GFR 2017, single bid can be accepted if the procurement was satisfactorily advertised and sufficient time was given for submission of bids. The qualification criteria were not unduly restrictive and prices are reasonable in the comparison to market values. The CEO also informed the Board that due to Belagavi Smart City project and shifting of Wholesale Vegetable Market, the collection of parking fees is reduced tremendously. CEO further informed that the bid of Rs. **Rs.19,26,000/-** presently received is much more than the amount received per day from the present contractor.

It was also brought to the notice of the Board that the highest bidder has submitted experience certificate of hawker fees instead of parking fees collection. Taking into consideration the present loss of the revenue and poor response for the said tender, the Board unanimously decided that if the highest bidder produced the requisite experience certificate of parking fee, the highest bid received from **Shri Sagar Babu Kamanache** be accepted and annual contract for collection of parking fees be awarded to him for a period of one year from the date of handing over the rights.

**15. PROVIDING VARIOUS STAFF FROM MANPOWER SERVICE PROVIDERS / ORGANISATIONS / AGENCIES ON OUTSOURCING BASIS TO THE CANTONMENT BOARD OFFICE, BELGAUM FOR THE YEAR 2019-2020:**

Cantonment Board, Belgaum had published E-tender notice bearing No.Outsourcing Agency/1514 dated 02-01-2020 in three local news papers for providing various staff on outsourcing basis to the Cantonment Board, Belgaum for the year 2019-2020 i.e. one year from the date of execution of contract. The said tender was opened on 21-01-2020. Total 07 tenders were received out of which one tender has qualified in the technical bid. As per Financial Bid one M/s. 1 Roof Solution has quoted the lowest rate at 2.05% service charges. Therefore, it is recommended that the tender submitted by 1 Roof Solution quoted at lowest rate 2.05% service charges be accepted.

The Board may decide accordingly.

The E-tenders received are placed on the table.

**Resolution :**

**15.** Considered and approved the lowest rate quoted by 1 Roof Solutions.

Before the close of the meeting, the following points came up for discussion :-

1. The President, Cantonment Board suggested to the Board that the maintenance of street lights of entire Belgaum City should be given to one agency for smooth functioning of the same.
2. Shri. Sajeed N. Shaikh, Elected Member expressed to the Board that if SFC is given to the Board, it should be given without any conditions. The SFC is a separate entity. It should not be equated with Octroi Grant. What funds are coming to the Corporation, the equal amount of funds should come directly to the Cantonment Board.
3. Shri. Anil S. Benake, MLA was requested by the Board to do follow-up with the Principal Secretary towards release of SFC grant through proper channel. He stated that once the grants are allocated, there are so many conditions to fulfill. The rules made by the Govt. should be strictly followed.
